CHRISTMAS PARTIES

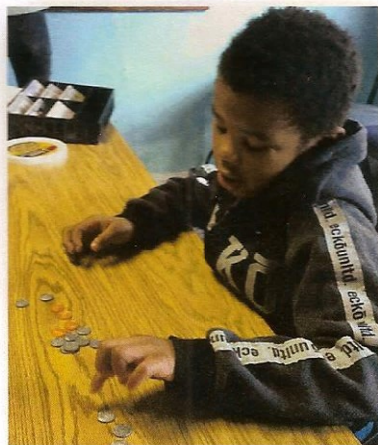
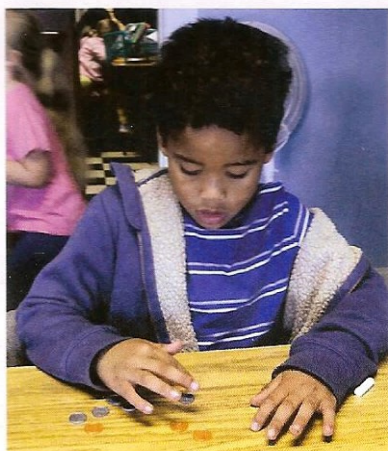
We are having four different parties from the 17th to the 23rd of December, and already churches and friends are asking how they can help. We expect about 20 adults and 60 children to attend the different parties.

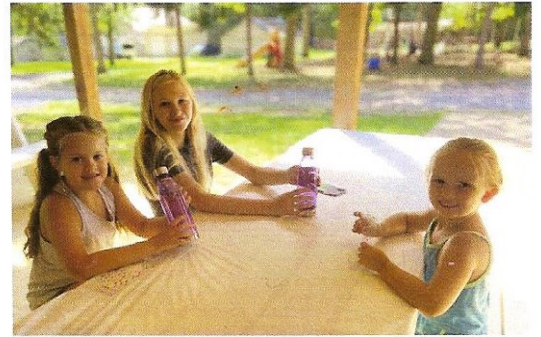
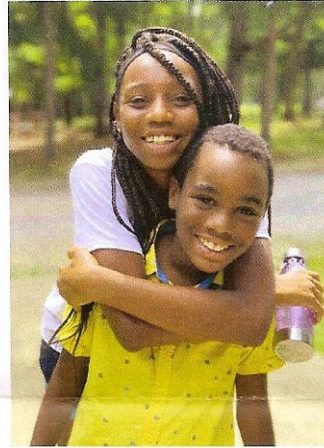
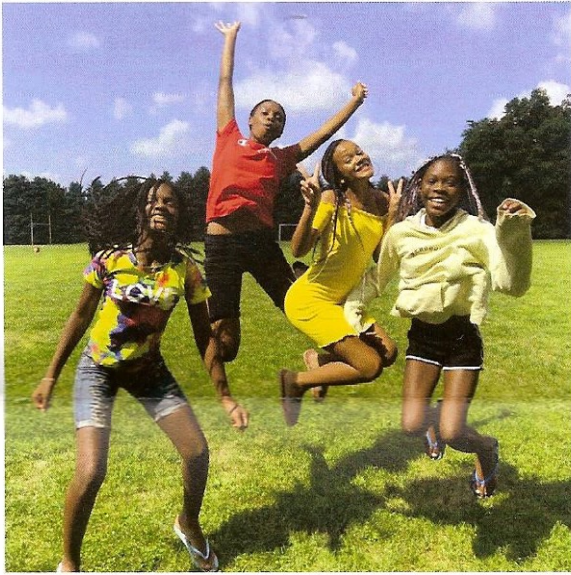
TUTORING

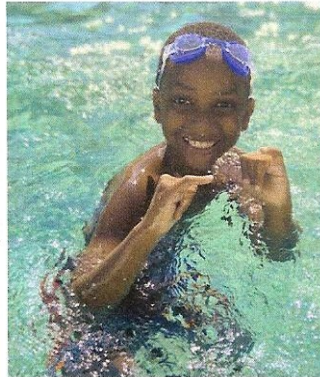
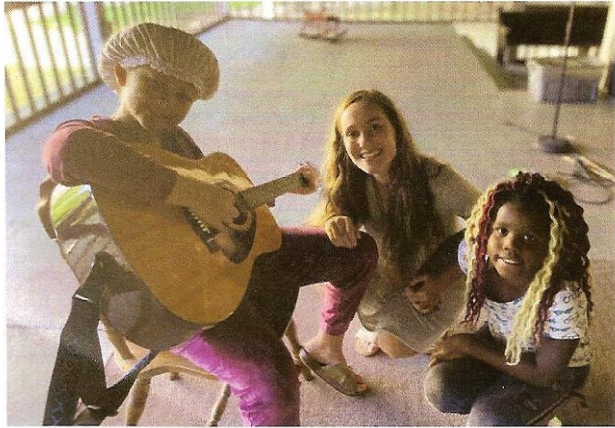

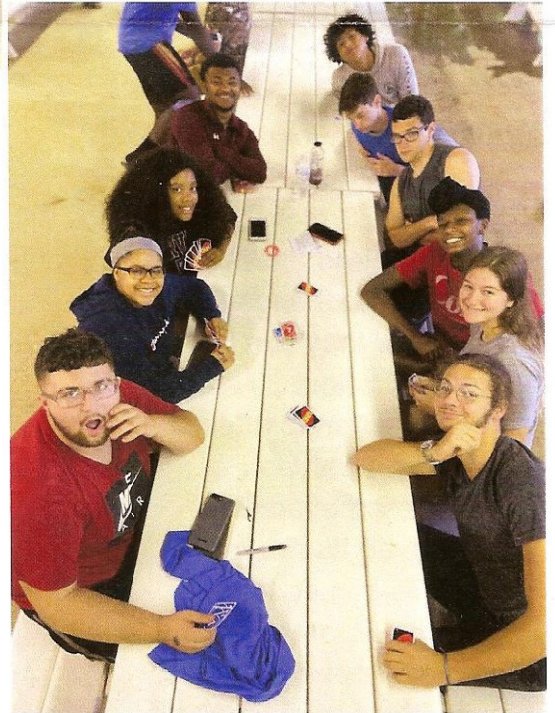
