About 15 years ago, a group of young boys and girls between the ages of 5 and 10 started attending the Center. This special group of kids came almost every day and soon became like a family to us and to each other. As the years have gone by, it has brought us great joy to see a lot of these kids grow up and go to college, or go right into the work force. But what brings us the greatest joy is to see them living for the Lord into their adult lives. I can't think of a better example of this than the young man, Terry, whose story is told below.

"I have been attending the Christian Community Center for 19 years and this place has become my second home. By living three doors down from the Center, I had the privilege to attend for so many years. In 2004, I gave my life to Christ. In 2009, a close friend of mine (Anthony-pictured above) died in a tragic accident. In the book of Ecclesiastes, Solomon stated that "a good name is better than fine perfume, and the day of death is better than the day of birth." Anthony People had impacted many people in his life and was remembered for his walk with Christ. After the funeral, I had to let the Holy Spirit convict me and change my ways. My pastor started to do one-on-one Bible studies with me until I graduated from high school. In college I had to defend my faith countless times in many of my classes. At CCBC my professor and I were debating about the existence of God. Three years later I saw my professor post something on Facebook in regard to persecuted Christians. He is now saved and has been living for the Lord faithfully and has joined a local church with his wife. I am now about to graduate from Towson University with a Bachelor's Degree in Health Care Management."

Terry is graduating this December and then plans to work full time at Mercy Hospital while he pursues a master's degree. What a fine young man he has become. Terry and many of the friends he grew up with at the mission are pictured right. All of these young adults were counselors and helpers at camp this past summer. We thank God for how he has worked in their lives.
