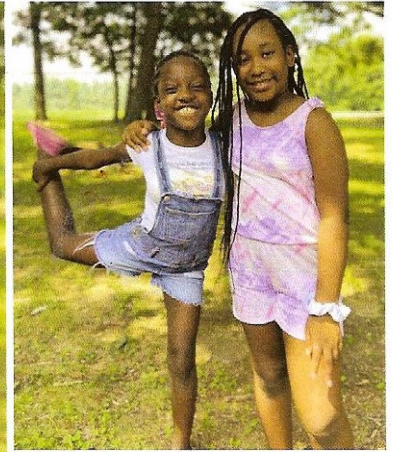
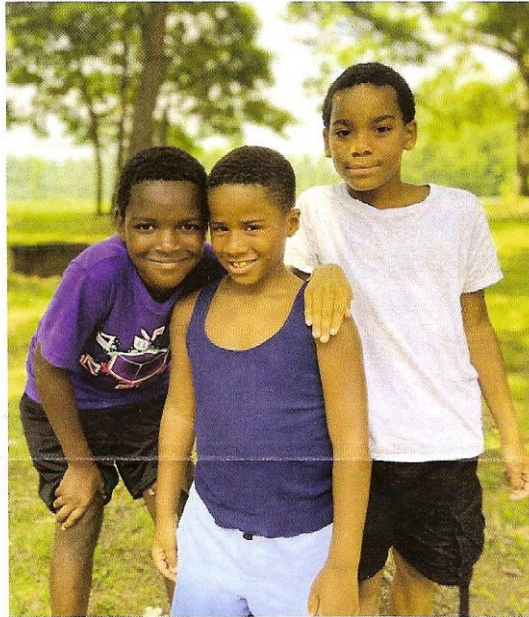


## CAMP

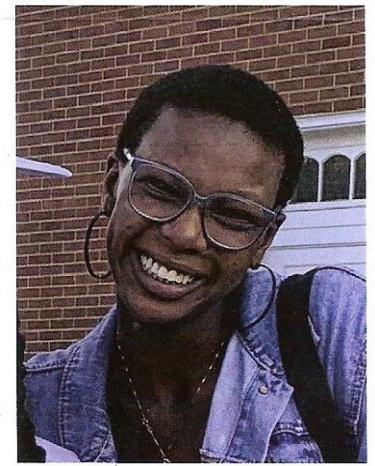
## GRADUATES

*Left-Brionna Right-Danaija*

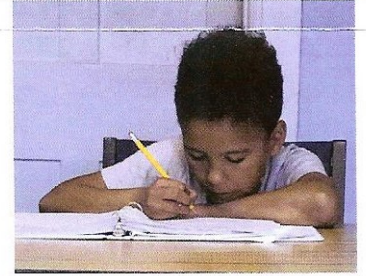
